The new keys are supplied after membership renewal.
The front gate to Barossa Go-Kart Club **must always be re-locked after entry**, and only member Karts are allowed on the track.
It is the responsibility of the last member leaving the track to ensure that the front gate is locked.

Free Practice Must be run per rule 13.20 of the AKA rule book.
There are 3 groups, Midgets/Rookies, Juniors & Seniors.
AT NO TIME AT ALL shall any of these groups be on the track together with **NO EXCEPTION**. A clock is set up to break down the hour for practice, this must be followed at all times unless you are the only member present.
Members are not permitted to practise on their own.

Licence Every member who uses a kart on an A.K.A. Member track must be the holder of a Current AKA Licence. Licences are issued by the A.K.A. State Secretary,

NOTE Members whose licences have expired and do not renew within 30 days must return their track key.

House Keeping

Please place rubbish and recycling in appropriate bins.

All Children are to be kept **under adult supervision at all times.**

Safety

When using the track, it is the member's responsibility to check that all Safety tyre barriers are in place before and after driving their karts, and that branches from trees have fallen on the track, are removed.
Your assistance is required to ensure a safer cleaner track for all members. All karts must comply with the current AKA rule book.
e.g. - have side pods and air box, including allocated kart numbers etc.
All drivers must wear protective clothing as per AKA Rule book, which includes helmet, gloves, driving suit and footwear covering the ankle.
Rules are displayed in the pit area and at the front gate, and must be followed at all times.

No cars or trailers are allowed to be parked in the pits.

No work or refuelling is to be carried out on the bitumen, and the *in and out* gates of the pits are to be used accordingly.

All karts using AKA approved tracks shall have a kart number.

Recreational Drivers

For 2010, Members who use the track facility for recreational driving (non-competition) will be required to hold an **E Grade Race Licence**.
Karts must display a **Red Rear number plate with white numbers.**

Track disputes If there is a conflict with other drivers please record kart numbers and car registrations and report details to the Club.

Types of memberships 2010

Individual membership:- Adults 17 years and over.

Family memberships:-

Juniors, Rookies and Midgets must join within a family membership with a parent taking out the prime membership.

These younger members must not use the track without this adult member being present.

Children may also be dependant full time students aged between 17 years and under the age of 25 years.

All family members must live at the same address.

All memberships are at the discretion of the committee.

Annual Fees:- **Individual Membership** \$176.00 inc GST plus \$11.00 key fee.

Family Membership \$176:00 inc GST plus \$11.00 key fee.

Half year Membership (from 1st July)
\$ 93:50 inc GST plus \$11.00 key fee.

Pit Spot (reserved) \$33.00 inc GST.

Trailer Park/Pit Spot (If available) \$55.00 inc GST

If paying by **Credit Card** add **\$3.50.**

Refund of \$11.00 if old key returned with application form, firmly secured inside the envelope.
