4.2	MEDICAL SERVICES
a)	Any Medical assistance that is required outside of the operating hours when Kart's are not on the Race Track please contact 000. The address to give to the Emergency Services is: Mount Gambier Karting Club, corner of Princess Highway and Brown Road, Glenburnie.
4.3	KART RETRIEVAL
a)	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during any demonstration.
b)	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, and only via the out grid.
c)	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a high visibility safety vest on the upper torso.
4.4	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
a)	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility except those in use by the disabled.
b)	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
c)	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
d)	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5	AKASA HOT WEATHER POLICY
