#### **4. CIRCUIT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS**

<b>1.</b>	<b>KART RETRIEVAL</b>
<b>1.1.</b>	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit.
<b>1.2.</b>	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
<b>1.3.</b>	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
<b>1.4.</b>	Karts can be retrieved via the In Grid
<b>2.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>2.1.</b>	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals allowed anywhere within the facility.
<b>2.2.</b>	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
<b>2.3.</b>	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
<b>2.4.</b>	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
<b>2.5.</b>	<b>AKASA HOT WEATHER POLICY</b> If the weather is predicted to be 39 degrees or greater (on the day of the meeting) as per the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) on the Thursday night (6:00pm) prior to the event, a posting will be made on the AKASA Website as soon as possible after 6:00pm informing drivers that the meeting may be postponed.
