<b>3.</b>	<b>KART RETRIEVAL</b>
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during any Sessions.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the Out Grid.
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	<b>AKASA HOT WEATHER POLICY</b> If the weather is predicted to be 39 degrees or greater (on either days of the meeting) as per the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) on the Thursday night (06:00pm) prior to the event, a posting will be made on the AKASA Website as soon as possible after 06:00pm informing drivers that the meeting may be postponed.
