<b>3.1.</b>	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
<b>3.2.</b>	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
<b>3.3.</b>	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
<b>3.4.</b>	Karts can be retrieved via the out grid.
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>4.1.</b>	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
<b>4.2.</b>	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
<b>4.3.</b>	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
<b>4.4.</b>	No motorised scooters, mini-bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
<b>4.5.</b>	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
