**Agenda Item:**

- Return to practice following COVID-19
  - MR distributed proposed document prepared by GKCSA

**Clubs position**

- WGKC – happy with proposed document
- MGKC – spoken to several committee members and happy to proceed with caution
- GKCSA – wanting to open as early as Sunday
- BGKC – waiting for tonight’s discussion
- SGKC – Remaining closed due to social responsibility concerns
  
- KA – keen as anyone to get karts out on track. KA developing document covering health matters approved by Dr May. To incorporate:
  - Supplementary Regulations to outline and enforce COVID-19 requirements
  - Process for taking bookings
  - Requirement for online declaration
  - Confirming essential and permitted personnel
  - Social distancing requirements
  - Document to be finalised within the next week
  - Preference for SA to hold off for a week to utilise
  - Ensure all documentation in place to cover state requirements

#### Areas of discussion

- Cleaning of toilets between sessions including disinfectant
- Supplementary Regulations can be prepared to cover a period of time
- Not restricted to weekends but must have essential people/supervisors.
- Reasonable abundance of caution
- Must be fluid and adaptable as each State changes legislative requirements
  
- *Motion: WGKC / MGKC To follow direction of KA as outlined in the COVID-19 Restricted Social Karting Supplementary Regulations with the view for clubs to re-commence practice in SA from Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> May – unanimous*

Thank you from KA for extending the invitation to include them in our ongoing discussions. Requirement of National Body to ensure we do it right – SA leading the way as it appears we may be the first to be able to re-open. Confident that with the current state legislation providing the necessary precautions are taken, it would be safe to reopen.
